YOUTH PROTECTION AWARENESS SESSIONS

The troop will be conducting a "Youth Protection Awareness" session for our Scouts. This program is a complement to the "Youth Protection Training" that all active adults are required to take every 2 years. This session will take place on 5/14/13, during the regular troop meeting. The plan is to have this session yearly.

A.) This is a required session for all Scouts. If a Scout does not attend (for any reason) his parent must sign a form (before the next campout) indicating that a parent has covered these topics with the Scout. The PowerPoint presentation will be made available afterwards.

B.) We will have a "parent preview" of this session on 5/7/13 (where parents will be given the exact same presentation, and have time for Q&A). ALL parents are strongly encouraged to attend. If after this session, you choose not to send your Scout on 5/14/13, see "A" above.

SWIM TESTS

MAY 28TH! SAVE THE DATE!

[BSA Swimmer Tests](#) will be held on the evening of Tuesday, May 28th at the Perimeter Church pool, before and during the regular Troop meeting. Although this is primarily designed to simplify our firstday at Summer Camp, these swim tests are available to all Scouts AND adults in Troop 317. The test is required for all Scouts and adults to participate at Summer Camp or any water-related Troop outing (you never know when we'll be tubing or canoeing) and is valid for one (1) year. Also, this is a chance for any Scout to partially complete the 2nd Class and/or 1st Class rank requirements. This includes only 2nd Class 8b and 1st Class 9b at this time, although adult leadership will consider plans for offering the completion of the other swim-related requirements (2nd Class 8a & 8b, 1st Class 9c).

ADULT & SCOUT MEDICAL FORMS

(New clinic information added 05/04/13)

Thanks to all who have already submitted their medical forms. Just a reminder that all medical forms must be submitted to Irene He **NO LATER THAN MAY 14TH. See below for more details on medicals forms and Irene's contact information below.**

The BSA medical form is necessary and required information for Troop leadership during our outings. Since it expires after a year, it is time to resubmit it for most all scouts and the adults.

This is especially important for all those attending the upcoming Camporee since we must submit copies to the Camporee Staff when we arrive. To help make this happen, Irene He will be collecting Parts A & B for all Scouts and Adults at the next Troop meeting on April 9th. Those attending Summer Camp, can also turn in Parts A & B, plus Part C at that time since they are due on or before May 14th!

The current BSA Medical form is available at this link; <http://troop317.pbworks.com/w/file/63923349/2013-Annual-Heath-Medical-Form.pdf>. Note the following simplified instructions:

1. Parts A & B are to be completed and signed by a Parent or the adult and required for ALL Scouts and Adults.
2. Additionally Part C is required for long-term camping and high adventure outings such as Summer
