

Den Chief

Introduction: The Den Chief works with the Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts and Den Leaders in the Cub Scout Pack. The Den Chief represents his Troop well by serving as a good example to the Cub Scouts of what they can become. By accepting the position of Den Chief, you agree to provide service and leadership to your troop. The responsibility should be fun and rewarding. This job description outlines some of the things you are expected to do while serving in this leadership role.

Advisor / Adult Mentor: Den Leader in the Pack and your Assistant Scoutmaster

Specific Duties:

- Knows the purposes of Cub Scouting.
- Helps Cub Scouts advance through Cub Scout ranks.
- Encourages Cub Scouts to join a Boy Scout troop upon graduation.
- Assists with activities in the den meetings.
- Is a friend to the boys in the den.
- Helps out at weekly den meetings and monthly pack meetings.
- Meets with adult members of the Den, Pack and Troop as necessary.
- Sets a good example.
- Enthusiastically wears the Scout uniform correctly.
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows Scout spirit.
- Maintain an activity log of duties performed for this position, including date, description of duties and time spent.
- Other projects as assigned by your Advisor.

Resources: As Den Chief, there are many resources available to you to help you do your job. These include people such as your Scoutmaster, ASM's, Troop Committee Members, and other Scouts. Other resources include teachers, religious leaders, community leaders, and fellow junior leaders. There is also literature available, some of which you'll find at the Scout shop.
